The MOU (memorandum of understanding) was an agreement between the Portsmouth Town Council, the Portsmouth School Department and The Prudence Island School Foundation (PISF) It was signed in 2009 and terminated early this year by the School Dept. It gave the PISF "civic support" for Island children grades K-4 who wanted to remain on the Island for schooling. It allowed the PISF to use the Prudence Island School to "home school."
