This letter is to inform you of my resignation from the Glen Manor House Authority effective immediately, because of my election to the Portsmouth Town Council.

I first became involved with the Glen Manor House Authority through my service on the Elmhurst Re-use Committee and my unsuccessful campaign to Preserve the Elmhurst Chapel — which I still contend was the correct route. After the Elmhurst Re-use Committee was dissolved, I applied and was appointed to a vacancy on the Glen Manor House Authority.

I have truly enjoyed my tenure on the Authority. Working together with a diverse group of colleagues, the Authority always had the goals of preserving the Glen Manor House and increasing revenues to the Town. I tender my resignation trusting the Council will make a considered, deliberate choice of a replacement to continue the Glen Manor House Authority's mission.
