The Portsmouth Fire Department is an all career fire department that is augmented with civilian emergency dispatchers. The department was organized in 1936 as Portsmouth Volunteer Fire Department. Over the years, the Department transitioned from a volunteer organization to a combination department, and now a fully paid fire department

The Town of Portsmouth is accepting applications from individuals that are currently career Fire Fighters in the State of Rhode Island. This is to establish a lateral certification eligibility list of qualified Fire Fighters.

Employment applications are required and available online at www.portsmouthri.com.

Completed applications with supporting certifications may be submitted in person by appointment to Human Resources or emailed to hr@portsmouthri.com and must be received by the Human Resources Office no later than 2:00 p.m., Friday September 25, 2020.

The Town of Portsmouth has partnered with the Rhode Island Association of Fire Chief's and is sponsoring its first written firefighter exam on Saturday October 31, 2020. The score for this exam will be accepted by the Portsmouth Fire Department.
