Press Release – Town of Portsmouth Recycling of Christmas Trees

Portsmouth – December 23, 2019 – The Portsmouth Department of Public Works (401-683-0362) will pick up discarded Christmas trees using the following schedule based on voting precincts:

MONDAY, JANUARY 6, 2020

Precincts 2702 and 2703: You voted at Portsmouth Senior Center (2702) or CFP Center for Arts, Wellness, and Community (fka Common Fence Point Community Hall) (2703).

TUESDAY, JANUARY 7, 2020

Precinct 2704: You voted at Portsmouth High School.

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 8, 2020

Precincts 2705 and 2706: You voted at Melville School (2705) or Town Hall Council Chambers (2706).

THURSDAY, JANUARY 9, 2020

Precinct 2707: You voted at St. Barnabas Church.

FRIDAY, JANUARY 10, 2020

Precinct 2708: You voted at Portsmouth Middle School.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Trees must be placed at curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day.
- Trees must **NOT** be in plastic bags and must be totally stripped of ALL decorations and tinsel.
- Residents that miss their pick-up date can also bring Christmas trees to the Department of Public Works located off Hedly Street. Trees will NOT be accepted at the Transfer Station.
- Trees will be recycled into mulch that will be available free of charge to Portsmouth residents. For more information on when mulch is available, contact Portsmouth Public Works at (401) 683-0362.

In the event of inclement weather, this schedule may change. Contact Public Works at (401) 683-0362 for your new pick-up date.
